

# INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your purchase of Quik-Load. You are now the owner of the most innovative and most practical tube magazine loader ever invented! Please go to [www.Quik-Load.com](http://www.Quik-Load.com) for FAQs and helpful hints on YouTube.

The Quik-load fits over 90% \* of all rifles with no adjustment. If the magazine tube is too close the barrel for the Quik-Load to completely fit, simply tilt the Quik-Load out at the top.

**HOW TO USE THE QUIK-LOAD™**  
.22LR Rimfire Loader for Tube Magazines



**STEP 1**  
Slide open carrier.



**STEP 2**  
Load up to 17 .22LR shells into holes with bullet end pointing down.



**STEP 3**  
Slide carrier closed until it's locked into place.



**STEP 4**  
When ready to load, place dispensing hole over the magazine tube, upside down.

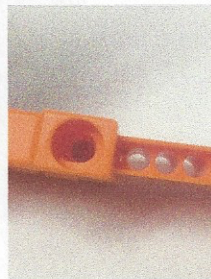


**STEP 5**  
Slowly slide carrier open to dispense ammo.

**You're ready to shoot!**

When you first use the Quik-Load pull slowly. As you use it more you will find the right pace to go faster on YOUR rifle. Even pulling slowly you will load in just a few seconds. If the carrier stops as you are pulling, back up 1/8 inch and continue pulling just a little slower. The Quik-Load works by gravity, lighter 36 grain ammo may have to be pulled slower than heavier and subsonic loads. For other hints visit the website or youtube!

**Alternate step 2 for loading 22mag and 17HMR:** When loading the longer cartridges start by inserting the empty carrier into the housing so the first hole is exposed. Load the carrier thru the dispensing hole, then slide the carrier in 1/4 inch and load the next cartridge. Continue until full or as many as you want to load. To use the Quik-Load exactly as you would with 22lr. To empty the carrier simply dispense them on to a clean surface rather than just removing the carrier !

\* the Browning BLR and some may have an oversized 'nut' at the end of the magazine tube. Quik-Load will still work however it may not fit completely over the tube. If that is the case, you will need to hold the Quik-Load in place manually.
